

BOAT RENTAL FEES

The marina rental fleet is available to qualified* individuals on a first come, first served basis. Scheduled training, races and regattas take precedence over recreational sailing.

Active duty may reserve boats up to two days in advance.
All other eligible patrons may reserve boats one day in advance.

*Qualification - All must have a Safe Boating and Operating Credential & pass an interview and check ride.

FISHING AT NAVAL STATION NEWPORT

In order to fish on base, you must have a RI Saltwater fishing license, go to <https://rio.ri.gov> to print one (free for Active-duty personnel). You must also have a base fishing license, call Environmental at (401) 841-7607. Licenses are only available Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-2:30 p.m. (no holidays) located in Building 1. **THERE IS NO FISHING AT THE PIERS, VEHICLE BRIDGES OR AT COASTERS HARBOR ISLAND MARINA.**



The Coasters Harbor Island Marina is the hub for berthing, sailing and powerboat training, recreational rentals and competitive sailing. A launch ramp and other services are located on Coasters' Harbor Island, adjacent to the Officers' Club, (inside Gate 1). The marina is open May through October.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: All students are required to have a SAFE BOATING CERTIFICATION accredited by their State/NASBLA or the US Coast Guard. Otherwise students must complete an online RI Safe Boating Course at: <http://www.boat-ed.com/rhodeisland> (separate fee payable to RI) and pass a state proctored exam given by MWR. You must show your State/NASBLA Certificate, US Coast Gurad License OR Online Course Completion Notice at your first sailing/powerboat class.

US SAILING BASIC KEELBOAT SAILING PROGRAM

The Coasters Harbor Island Marina offers US Sailing Basic Keelboat certification. This is a two week course, that consists of one classroom session and seven on-the-water classes in a Rhodes 19. Qualification for a US Sailing Basic Keelboat certification is based on demonstrated skills and knowledge. Students must ALSO complete a US Sailing online course and pass two exams proctored by MWR: (1) US Sailing written exam, (2) RI Safe Boating Exam (Unless you can show a current National Association of Boating Law Administrators Safe Boating Certificate from any state).



MINIMUM AGE FOR QUALIFICATIONS IS 18.

Training courses and end times are subject to weather and sunset time. Students must attend all scheduled sessions.

The Navy Sail & Powerboat Program requires all participants to wear personal flotation devices while being trained on the water.

TRAINING CLASS REGISTRATION

Sign up, in person, for sailing or powerboat lessons at the marina (must bring military/DoD ID). May 1 - 7: Active-duty personnel/ Reservists. May 8: Retirees/DoD/Contractors.

US POWERBOATING SAFE POWERBOAT HANDLING PROGRAM

A US Powerboating qualification and training course is offered through the marina. This 8-hour program consists of a classroom session and on-the-water instruction. Students must demonstrate proficiency in powerboat operation and pass two exams proctored by MWR: (1) US Powerboating written exam, (2) RI Safe Boating Exam (Unless you can show a current National Association of Boating Law Administrators Safe Boating Certificate from any state). Participants who complete this course will be qualified to rent a 18-foot Maritime Skiff at Naval Station Newport.
